Golden Rings Retreat;

The Five Rings are a journey through the living landscapes of the heart, earth, spirit, sky, and fire. Each ring offers a unique doorway into transformation, inviting you to slow down, awaken your senses, deepen your relationship with the natural world, and remember the wisdom already within you. Through guided journeys, ceremony, storytelling, creativity, and

community, each gathering builds upon the last, weaving together a path of compassion, belonging, vision, and purpose. Whether you attend a single ring or walk the full circle, each experience offers its own medicine while contributing to a deeper journey of remembering who you are.

Spiral Dance; Celtic Traditions and Rituals

The Spiral is an invitation to embrace transformation as a living, cyclical journey. Rather than seeking a destination, we learn to trust the wisdom found in returning, remembering, and growing through each season of life. Through guided shamanic journeys, ceremony, storytelling, creative expression, and embodied practice, participants explore the patterns that have shaped them, release what no longer serves, and reconnect with the deeper wisdom of their soul. Together, we walk the Spiral with curiosity, courage, and compassion, discovering that every ending holds the seed of a new beginning.

Shamanic Training Level I; Foundations of Shamanic Practice

An immersive introduction to shamanic practice designed to build a strong foundation in ethical journey work and personal spiritual development.

Topics: History and ethics of shamanic practice, the Three Worlds, protection and energetic boundaries, journeying with the drum, meeting helping spirits, Power Animal Retrieval, nature connection, working with the elements, ceremony and intention, spiritual hygiene, compassionate witnessing,

*integrating journey experiences,
developing a daily practice.*

Shamanic Training Level II; Healing & Personal Transformation

A training focused on deepening personal healing while learning foundational shamanic healing practices.

Topics: Compassionate extraction, Soul Retrieval, psychopomp work and compassionate spirit release, ancestral healing, shadow work, sacred boundaries, deepening intuition, ethics in healing practice, case studies, integration practices.

Shamanic Training Level III; Community, Facilitation & Stewardship

Meant for preparing practitioners to bring their gifts into service through community leadership, facilitation, ceremony, and ethical practice.

Topics: Facilitating groups, holding sacred space, community healing, ceremony design, land work, navigating challenging situations, professional ethics, teaching skills, building a sustainable practice, stewardship, leadership, walking between worlds in everyday life.
